PUBLIC HEARING

1. **PUBLIC HEARING** (continued from February 2, 2017): TO HEAR PUBLIC OPINION REGARDING THE AMENDMENT OF LAND USE ASSUMPTIONS, CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PLANS, AND ASSOCIATED IMPACT FEES FOR WATER, AND WASTEWATER AND ROADWAY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS.

BUSINESS: Consider and discuss the amendment of land use assumptions, capitals improvements plans, and associated impact fees for water, wastewater and roadway capital improvements.

2. **PUBLIC HEARING:** To hear public opinion regarding a request from the property owner and applicant, Ramona Osburn, Senior Vice President at Texas Health Resources Behavioral Health, for a zoning change through an ordinance amending the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance being a part of the Unified Development Code, Ordinance No. 13-05-02-08, as amended, and a portion of Planned Development Ordinance No. 99-03-18-05, as amended, by amending the zoning to Planned Development C-2 Commercial District and adding "Hospital" as a Permitted Use on Lot 1, Block A, Corinth Medical Center Addition being 5.00 acres in the City of Corinth, Denton County, Texas.

BUSINESS: Consider and act on an ordinance amending the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance being a part of the Unified Development Code, Ordinance No. 13-05-02-08, as amended, and a portion of Planned Development Ordinance No. 99-03-18-05, as amended, by amending the zoning to Planned Development C-2 Commercial District and adding "Hospital" as a Permitted Use on Lot 1, Block A, Corinth Medical Center Addition being 5.00 acres in the City of Corinth, Denton County, Texas.

Consider and act on an Ordinance of the City of Corinth, Texas, amending Chapter 36 of the Corinth Code of Ordinance by adopting updated Land Use Assumptions, Water and Wastewater Impact Fee Reports, updated land use assumptions, updated water and wastewater Capital Improvements Plans, and amendments to the assessment of Impact Fees for water treatment distribution facilities and wastewater collection and Impact Fees amounts to be collected; amending Chapter 50 by deletion of Sections 50.50 50.55; providing for the repeal of all ordinances in conflict; providing a severability clause, and providing an effective date.
- 6. Consider and act on an Ordinance of the City of Corinth, Texas, amending Chapter 36 of the Corinth Code of Ordinance by adopting updated Land Use Assumptions, Roadway Impact Fee Reports, updated land use assumptions, updated roadway Capital Improvements Plan, and amendments to the assessment of Impact Fees for roadway facilities and Impact Fees amounts to be collected; providing for the repeal of all ordinances in conflict; providing a severability clause, and providing an effective date.
- 7. Accept Certification of City Secretary of Unopposed Status and Consider Resolution repealing Resolution No. 17-02-02-01 Ordering and Calling a Joint/General Election for May 6, 2017.

COUNCIL COMMENTS & FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS

CLOSED SESSION

The City Council will convene in such executive or (closed session) to consider any matters regarding any of the above listed agenda items as well as the following matters pursuant to Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.

<u>Section 551.071.</u> (1) Private consultation with its attorney to seek advice about pending or contemplated litigation; and/or settlement offer; and/or (2) a matter in which the duty of the attorney to the government body under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State of Texas clearly conflicts with chapter 551.

Section 551.072. To deliberate the purchase, exchange, lease or value of real property:

a. Lake Sharon Project - Right-of-Way acquisitions.

<u>Section 551.074.</u> To deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee; or to hear a complaint or charge against an officer or employee.

<u>Section 551.087.</u> To deliberate or discuss regarding commercial or financial information that the governmental body has received from a business prospect that the governmental body seeks to have locate, stay, or expand in or near the territory of the governmental body and with which the governmental body is conducting economic development negotiations; or to deliberate the offer of a financial or other incentive to a business prospect.

After discussion of any matters in closed session, any final action or vote taken will be in public by the City Council. City Council shall have the right at any time to seek legal advice in Closed Session from its Attorney on any agenda item, whether posted for Closed Session or not.

RECONVENE IN OPEN SESSION TO TAKE ACTION, IF NECESSARY, ON CLOSED SESSION ITEMS.

Consider and take action regarding the purchase, exchange, lease or value of real property:

a. Lake Sharon Project - Right-of-Way acquisitions.
